- Applicants to demonstrate full hazard identification of performance area, risk controls to ensure a safe working environment.
- Demonstration of all performance criteria to work safely at heights in accordance with the Australian Standards by trainer and student.

- Nationally Accredited Statement of Attainment
- On successful completion of the training assessment applicants will be issued with a competency card, for working safely on scaffolding higher than two metres issued by Australian Easy Train.
